REGISTRATION & CLUB FACTS

- 1) All formal communication from parents to executive, administrative and technical staff must be submitted via their designated team Head coach or Appointed Team Manager.
- 2) Parents/guardians of registered players of the Surrey United Soccer Club **must complete, sign and abide by the player/parent code of conduct.** This can be obtained from the designated team manager or from our official website www.surreyunitedsoccer.com.
- 3) Practice days and times are determined by the BCPL General Manager and will be posted at the start of the season.
- 4) Any player wishing to play up an age group must obtain approval from the club Technical Director.
- 5) The BCSPL season will run from January 2012 to November 2012.
- 6) Provincial Cup competitions are typically held in last week June/first week July.
- 7) Games are typically played on Saturdays and/or Sundays
- 8) Players are expected to commit to all training sessions and games associated with their team.
